# Spring 2008 Regattas at Harsha Lake

## Directions to Harsha Lake

The course is located on Harsha Lake in East Fork State Park, Ohio. The park is 40 Minutes east of Cincinnati, Ohio, approximately a 2.5 hour drive from Columbus.

### □ Directions from Columbus, Ohio:

- Take I-71 South to I-275 East
- Take I-275 East to exit 65: Rte. 125, Amelia/Beechmont Ave. (SE part of the 275 loop). You are still ½ hour from the site...
- Turn left (to Amelia) on Beechmont for 9.8 miles. WARNING: speed limit in Amelia is 25 mph. The cops will be speed trapping, so drive slowly.
- DO **NOT** TURN LEFT onto Rte. 222, by Phantom Fireworks, even though you will see a Harsha Lake sign, instead.....
- Turn LEFT at the traffic light onto Bantam Rd. Rte. 222 turns right at this intersection. On regatta weekends, there is often a banner at the corner.
- ▪ Follow Bantam Rd. 0.2 miles to the entrance to East Fork State Park.
- ▪ Turn LEFT into the park and follow signs to the Beach.
- Turn LEFT 0.9 miles later (there is a sign for the Beach) and follow down to the beach.
- Park where instructed or in a marked parking space if no one is there to direct you. You may have to park in a remote lot at the top of the hill and walk to the race site – approx. 15-min walk, or there may be a shuttle bus.

**Driving Directions from Upper Arlington to Hampton Inn (team hotel located at Exit 63B, 858 Eastgate North Drive):**

- ❖ Take 315S to I-71S
- ❖ MERGE onto I-275E via exit 17A toward OH-32
- ❖ MERGE onto OH-32E VIA Exit 63B toward Batavia
- ❖ Make a U-TURN at Glen Este-Withamsville Road onto OH-32W
- ❖ Turn RIGHT onto Jackson Square Drive
- ❖ Turn RIGHT onto Eastgate North Drive

**From Hampton Inn to Harsha Lake:**

- ❖ Drive SE on Eastgate North Drive toward Wyler Park Drive
- ❖ Turn RIGHT onto Wyler Park Drive
- ❖ Turn RIGHT onto Glen Este-Withamsville Road
- ❖ Turn LEFT on OH-32 E/OH-32
- ❖ Take the Main Street ramp toward Batavia/Kent Road
- ❖ Keep RIGHT at the fork to go on W. Main Street
- ❖ Turn RIGHT onto Foundry Ave/OH-132. Continue to follow OH-132.
- ❖ Turn LEFT onto OH-125
- ❖ Turn LEFT at the traffic light onto Bantam road. Rte 222 turns right at this intersection. On regatta weekends, there is often a banner at the corner.
- ❖ Follow Bantam Road, 0.2 miles to the entrance to East Fork State Park.
- ❖ Turn LEFT into the park and follow signs to the Beach.
- ❖ Turn LEFT 0.9 miles later (there is a sign for the Beach) and follow down to the beach.
